- Your abstract should include a title, authors and affiliations
- Font type, size, colour: Arial | 10 | Black
- Spacing: Single space
- Word count: 300
- Abstract should be submitted in **Word format**, **No PDF** submissions will be accepted
- Short biography: 100-word limit
- You may include a head & shoulders photograph of yourself as indicated on the template
- Please make sure that your abstract fits onto a single page
